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The Master of Science in Accounting is designed for students who plan to pursue their Certified Public Accounting (CPA) credential. You will graduate with the incremental credits needed to meet the 150 hour educational requirement for the Board of Accountancy* in your state.

Offered through the College of Adult and Graduate Studies, the program is intended to equip accountants to apply their expertise and fiduciary responsibilities with a Christian worldview and ethical leadership. Coursework topics include:

- Accounting ethics
- Accounting research
- Advanced auditing (accounting information systems systematically examined using a forensic framework)
- Advanced tax accounting

The Master of Science in Accounting is reserved for students who have an undergraduate degree in accounting.

Master of Business Administration

The Master of Business Administration programs at Colorado Christian University focus on management and leadership. You will develop critical thinking, decisionmaking, and people management skills. Many different styles of leadership are explored including transactional, transformational, authentic, and "servant leadership" from a biblical perspective, incorporating the eternal wisdom and love of Jesus Christ in the way you lead others. You will actively engage in endeavors that have a sustainable impact in public policy and social change, encouraging you to apply your learning experience in real time.

CCU's MBA programs are ideal for adults who aspire toward senior management positions, such as CEO or COO, or want to be successful business owners or ministry leaders. The principles and skills you'll acquire will apply to you in both for-profit and nonprofit fields, as well as the military and law enforcement — virtually any organizational setting.

CCU's MBA program offers six emphases: Leadership, Advanced Accounting, Healthcare Administration, Project Management, Cyber Security, and Enterprise Agility.

Students can use credit by portfolio to substitute up to nine (9) credits (three courses) or add a custom emphasis.

The Master of Arts in Clinical Mental Health Counseling program at Colorado Christian University combines compelling coursework, professional practice, and mentoring relationships designed to equip you to be a professional counselor who is responsive to all cultures. The curriculum is taught within a Christian framework, giving you the unique opportunity to integrate Christ-like faith and sound clinical counseling principles within an ethical practice.

Offered both online and in-seat, this 60-credit hour (CACREP Accredited) counseling program gives you the flexibility to earn your master's degree where it's most convenient for you. In addition to your core curriculum, you are offered a variety of electives that include Neuroscience and Clinical Counseling, Substance Abuse Disorders, and Child and Adolescent Diagnosis and Treatment.

Upon completion of CCU's M.A. in Clinical Mental Health Counseling program, you will be prepared to take the National Counselor Exam (NCE) and the National Clinical Mental Health Counseling Examination (NCMHCE). Emphasis in Marriage and Family Therapy

CCU's M.A. in Clinical Mental Health Counseling with an emphasis in Marriage and Family Therapy equips you in this specialized area of clinical mental health focus to provide prevention, intervention, and healing for hurting families, couples, and individuals. This program offers indepth understanding of interpersonal relationships, human behavior, social influence, mental and emotional issues or disorders, conflict resolution, and most importantly, family dynamics.

Offered through the College of Adult and Graduate Studies, this emphasis taught by seasoned Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFTs) prepares you for licensure and success as an LMFT in a clinical setting. Combining biblical truth with clinical competence, the Marriage and Family Therapy emphasis coursework covers topics ranging from contemporary couple relationships and social and cultural foundations for marriage and family to research and evaluation methods, along with ethical practice guidelines. Offered 100% online, these CACREP accredited courses are taken two at a time and are typically completed in sevenweek blocks. A five-day on-campus residency is required each summer, for a total of three residencies throughout the online marriage and family therapy counseling program.

Upon completion of CCU's M.A. in Clinical Mental Health Counseling with the Marriage and Family Therapy emphasis, you will be prepared to begin the process of seeking licensure as a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist. After graduation, you will have countless opportunities in a wide variety of settings as an LMFT, including employment with social services agencies, churches, addiction treatment centers, medical centers, or private practice. CCU's M.A. in Clinical Mental Health Counseling with an emphasis in Substance Use Disorders trains up compassionate counseling professionals with an integrated approach to mental health and addiction, providing leadership in developing, evaluating, and implementing holistic models for addiction treatment. Drawing on an approach that balances theological beliefs about addiction with the growing scientific knowledge available, this clinical mental health specialization encompasses biblically-based best practices in providing treatment and care for those suffering from alcohol and chemical substance addictions.

Offered through the College of Adult and Graduate Studies, the Substance Use Disorders emphasis, taught by industry leaders and licensed addictions counselors, prepares you for success within any realm of counseling that intersects with mental health disorders. The coursework combines evidence-based addiction treatments and clinical training, including differential diagnosis, trauma-informed treatment, complicating medical issues, psychopharmacology, and recovery management. Offered 100% online, these CACREP accredited courses are taken two at a time and are typically completed in seven-week blocks. A five-day on-campus residency is required each summer, for a total of three residencies throughout the online counseling program.

Upon completion of CCU's M.A. in Clinical Mental Health Counseling with the Substance Use Disorders emphasis, you will be prepared to begin the process of seeking certification and licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), and certification and licensure as an Addiction Counselor (certification and licensure standards will vary by state). After graduation, you will have countless opportunities in a wide variety of settings as a professional counselor, including employment with social services agencies, churches, addiction treatment centers, medical centers, or private practice. Master of Science in Psychology

The Master of Science in Psychology degree program is a great match for students who have already earned their bachelor's degree and want to further their ability to help others overcome challenges involving human behavior in a wide variety of career options or to serve as a stepping stone for further graduate studies including a doctoral degree in Psychology (Ph.D.). This 30-credit hour degree program is offered 100% online, with a format and flexibility that can be completed in as little as 15 months of consecutive coursework, even with a full-time job.

Some of the core and elective M.S. in Psychology courses include:

- Psychology of Faith
- Multi-Cultural and Social Issues in Psychology
- Techniques of Forensic Practice
- Motivational Psychology and Theory

Students acquire a thorough knowledge of the major theories and content areas comprising the foundation of psychology, all taught from a biblical perspective. Upon graduation, students will have an expanded range of job opportunities, including human resources, talent management, behavior analysis, law enforcement/ probation officer, social work, victim advocacy, juvenile offender counseling, casework, teaching, curriculum design, educational consulting, and school counseling.

For students seeking to further their professional journey and expand their career opportunities in the field of counseling, the Ph.D. in Counselor Education and Supervision (CES) offered through CCU's College of Adult and Graduate Studies leads the way forward. This doctoral degree focuses on developing biblically-anchored leaders and researchers in the counseling profession, enabling them to educate and mentor future counselors.

As the demand for qualified and competent mental health counselors continues to rise, the Ph.D. in CES addresses the corresponding need to train competent educators and leaders in the counseling profession. The program emphasizes a Christian faith-informed learning model to equip graduates to uphold the highest standards of servant leadership in their roles as counselor educators, scientists/ researchers, supervisors, and mental health and social advocates. The CES program is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association and developed in line with the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) standards.

Designed for mental health professionals, the Ph.D. in Counselor Education and Supervision is a non-licensure program offered nearly 100% online to meet the flexibility requirements of professional adult learners balancing family, work, and other commitments. In as little as three years (nine semesters), students work to complete 60 credit hours, including two in-person residencies in Colorado; students may also transfer up to 12 doctoral-level credit hours toward the Ph.D. program. If your career goals include a leadership position in criminal justice or a command position in law enforcement or security, then this program may be right for you. It is designed for those working in the field of criminal justice who may wish to move into leadership positions.

Criminal Justice Emphasis

CCU also offers four courses (12 credit hours) in Campus, Event, and Organizational Safety designed to address the alarming trend of mass violence in our culture through a worldview that supports the sanctity of life and a biblical view of human nature.

The courses may be completed as an optional emphasis in the M.S. in Criminal Justice program or as a stand-alone graduate certificate.

Master of Public Administration (MPA) graduates have a unique opportunity to profoundly impact the lives of others. Master of Education Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education degree addresses the need for licensed teachers to be knowledgeable in teaching English to speakers of other languages.

This graduate degree meets all requirements set forth by the Colorado Department of Education for an endorsement in Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education. The degree is also aligned with the standards for Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL). Students completing this degree are eligible to receive a TESOL Certificate.

Courses in this program are designed to provide professional development for current and aspiring educators and school professionals who are seeking skills in teaching English language learners both in the United States and around the world.

This program does not require educator licensure and does not lead to a licensure recommendation to the Colorado Department of Education. Individuals who successfully complete 24 credit hours or more may apply to the Colorado Department of Education for an added CLD endorsement to an existing educator license.

CLDE Endorsement

An endorsement in Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education is available for candidates who already have an active teaching license (or are eligible for a teaching license) and desire to teach in an English Language Learner (ELL) classroom.

The CLDE endorsement is awarded to candidates by the Colorado Department of Education upon the recommendation of Colorado Christian University.

Master of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction

The Master of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction (MACI) at Colorado Christian University provides you with the tools to enhance your educational career in teaching, training, administration, and curriculum development. The MACI degree is designed to further your cognitive abilities and relational skills. You will be able to apply a worldview informed by biblical scholarship as you learn to design and deliver curriculum.

You may earn a traditional master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction, or choose one of three options for an emphasis: Biblical Studies, Alternative Licensing, or Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education. The Alternative Licensing program is authorized by the Colorado Department of Education.

A total of 36 credit hours are required for the Master of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction degree. (You complete 18 credits from the professional core and the remaining credits will reflect whether or not you pursue an emphasis.)

To meet your professional needs, the M.Ed. in Special Education program has a range of options, which include a non-licensure or licensure track. The non-licensure track is for candidates who already have a teaching license or those who are seeking a Generalist endorsement. For candidates seeking licensure, they may pursue a license either through the M.Ed. licensure path or through the Alternative Licensing emphasis.

The Master of Education in Special Education program covers a range of traditional and innovative approaches to education that support best practices and strategic collaboration for leading public, private, charter, and international K-12 education. This Education master's degree is ideal for those with the desire to ensure highquality instruction for students with disabilities.

The program teaches candidates to apply evidence-based solutions to second language learning and teaching; to develop lessons focusing on critical language structures in support of second language development; to contextualize language instruction based on student proficiency levels and academic experience; and to plan, implement, and modify appropriate instructional strategies to meet the needs of English language learners.

The online TESOL Certificate is available as a stand-alone program, or you may transfer 15 credits from the certificate to a CCU master's degree in Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education or Curriculum and Instruction.

The Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) program is designed for nurses with a bachelor's degree in nursing who are ready to take on greater leadership roles in healthcare and education. The Doctor of Nursing Practice in Visionary Leadership at CCU is designed for nurses — nurse practitioners, nurse administrators and healthcare leaders, clinical nurse specialists, and nurse educators — who already have an MSN.

The online DNP at CCU is a practice-focused doctorate that will prepare experts in specialized advanced nursing practice. Graduates will be able to apply credible research and translate evidence-based practice into improved health outcomes. The doctoral program provides development of advanced competencies for increasingly complex practice and enhanced leadership to strengthen healthcare delivery.

The DNP equips graduates for career advancement in professional nursing including: Chief Nursing Officer (CNO); Director of Nursing; leadership in APRN practice, health policy, quality outcomes management; and nursing entrepreneurship.

CCU's DNP can be completed in two years of fulltime study. The program includes 525 hours of clinical experience beyond the MSN.
